- The DAISY Consortium has 106 members in 35 countries

EPUB 3 Key Accessibility Features

- Enriched semantic structure
- Support for synthesized speech pronunciation
- Navigation document that allows readers to quickly move through the structure of the book
- Support for synchronized audio and text enabled through "Media Overlays"
- DAISY and EPUB Standard are converging
- Reading experience already enjoyed by the many readers of DAISY Digital Talking Books around the world

- The DAISY Consortium has played an integral part in the development of EPUB 3
- The DAISY Consortium fully endorses this specification
- Plans are underway to implement EPUB 3 as a distribution format as quickly as possible
