






Highest Educational Attainment US Young Adults



Highest Educational Attainment US Young Adults



The United States now has the highest college dropout rate in the industrialized world.





Control Group Scores










Proportion of Live Ink Group with Score ≥ 21

















ENGLAND'S ENTRY INTO AMERICA

Among the gentlemen eager to win fame and fortune were Humphrey Gilbert and Walter Raleigh, two adventurers with conquistador appetites for more and more.
